



CPE KINDERGARTEN ADMISSION POLICY

It is College Prep Elementary School's policy that scholars applying to Kindergarten must turn 5 years of age on or before September 1 of the year they will be starting school.

Parents who are interested in enrolling their scholars that will be turning 5 years of age between September 2 and December 31, will be placed on a waiting list. If enrollment does not meet the targeted total enrollment four weeks before school begins, students on the waiting list will be evaluated.

The evaluation process will consist of assessments to see if the scholar is ready, emotionally, socially and academically, for school. The assessment will be a two-part evaluation. Based on the results of the evaluation and the decision of the Kindergarten Enrollment Committee, scholars will either be admitted or declined. If the scholar is admitted, he/she will have one week during the first week of school to interact with peers to make sure he/she is socially ready. The Kindergarten Enrollment Committee will determine at the conclusion of the week if that scholar can continue or should wait another year.

Students who are admitted for early enrollment under this policy will be subject to continuance of Kindergarten based on the guidance of the Kindergarten teacher.
